




The control of the fresh perishables supply chain is colorful



eRO – Port Community Ecosystem





Digitalization of import container release which is 3-5 times faster than the paper release process


- Digitize the import container release process among terminal, liner, consignee, forwarder, truckers, and depot
- Consignee submits request for eRO to liner with electronic documents and e-payment
- Liner issues eRO and makes subsequent information (FSP/FRP/LOC) update reflected in real-time
- Consignee forwards eRO to designated trucker which has to assign designated tractor for container pick-up securely


